

# Provincial Toilet Replacement Rebate Program

## Program Options:

The program currently offers two options for owners of residential housing:

For **single-family dwellings** (including individual condominiums), owners can qualify for a \$50 rebate per toilet replacement (up to 3 toilets per household) if the eligibility requirements are met. You may download the application form on the main page.

For **multi-unit dwellings**, you may apply directly for up to 20 toilets, but you must include proper receipts with your application form. If you would like to replace more than 20 toilets, we ask that you apply for pre-approval.

## Eligibility Requirements:

- Each new toilet must be certified under CSA or c-UPC with a flush volume of 6 litres or less. It must replace a toilet with a flush volume of 13 litres or more.
- The new toilet(s) is purchased after January 1, 2009.
- The structure was built prior to January 1, 2009. This rebate will not be available to structures built after this date, or for new additions to existing structures. This rebate is only for new toilets which **replace** older high-flush-volume toilets.
- You have not applied for a rebate for these toilets under the Saskatchewan EnerGuide for Houses program, which is distinct from this program.
- This rebate is applicable only for toilet replacements in dwellings and structures within Saskatchewan. Owners with mailing addresses outside of Saskatchewan may be eligible for the rebate if the location of the replaced toilet is within Saskatchewan.
- The original purchase receipt is submitted with your application.

## Eligible Structure Types:

### Single-Family Dwellings;

- Houses
- Single units within multiple-unit housing complexes

- Condominiums
- Cabins
- Cottages

**Multiple-Unit Dwellings:**

- apartment blocks (renter occupied, landlord owned)
- duplexes/triplexes/four-plexes etc. where centrally owned
- condominiums\*
- co-operatives (publicly and privately funded)
- care homes/nursing homes/seniors' residences
- group homes
- camps

\*Individual owners may apply for the single dwelling rebate for their own units.

**Municipal and First Nation Facilities:**

- Offices, maintenance buildings, recreational and cultural facilities
- Emergency services facilities

**Institutions:**

- Graded and post-secondary public and private schools
- Hospitals, clinics and public-access treatment centres

**Non-Profit Facilities:**

- Seniors' centres
- Churches and places of meeting and worship
- Offices
